Use naloxone to stop
a fentanyl overdose.

**Someone may be
overdosing if they:**

- Can't wake up.
- Are breathing irregularly or not at all.
- Are making a gurgling sound.
- Are turning blue, gray or purple, or their skin feels cold.


If you think someone may be overdosing, **call 911 and give them naloxone** (Narcan).

HOW TO USE NALOXONE

Lay the person down if they're sitting or slumped.

- 1** Open the box and packaging.
- 2** Place the nozzle inside either nostril.
- 3** Press the plunger all the way (until it clicks).
- 4** If they don't respond in 2 or 3 minutes, use another dose. It could take several doses to work.

Keep giving them naloxone or do CPR until they wake up or help arrives.
