BUPRENORPHINE/SUBOXONE®

- Prevents opioid withdrawal symptoms and cravings to focus on recovery
- ✓ Blocks the effects of other drugs if a person relapses
- Comes in several forms: a pill, a film under the tongue, as a 6-month implant under the skin or as a monthly injectable form
- Available to pregnant and parenting people

METHADONE

- Prevents opioid withdrawal symptoms and cravings to focus on recovery
- Effective for people who suffer from severe and chronic pain
- ✓ Comes in liquid or pill form
- Available to pregnant and parenting people
- ✓ Blocks the effects of Opioid drugs if a person relapses

NALTREXONE/VIVITROL®/REVIA®

- ✓ Blocks the effects of other drugs if a person relapses.
- Can be offered in any medical setting
- ✓ Comes in daily pill or monthly injection
- ✓ Works for both opioids and alcohol
