If you or a loved one are struggling with opioid use disorder, treatment, connection and culture can support recovery. Opioid use disorder can be successfully treated with a combination of medications, counseling and behavioral therapies designed to treat the whole person.

BUPRENORPHINE/SUBOXONE®

- ✓ Prevents opioid withdrawal symptoms and cravings to focus on recovery
 - ✓ Blocks the effects of other drugs if a person relapses
 - ✓ Comes in several forms: a pill, a film under the tongue, as a 6-month implant under the skin or as a monthly injectable form
 - ✓ Available to pregnant and parenting people
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METHADONE

- ✓ Prevents opioid withdrawal symptoms and cravings to focus on recovery
 - ✓ Effective for people who suffer from severe and chronic pain
 - ✓ Comes in liquid or pill form
 - ✓ Available to pregnant and parenting people
 - ✓ Blocks the effects of Opioid drugs if a person relapses
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NALTREXONE/VIVITROL®/REVIA®

- ✓ Blocks the effects of other drugs if a person relapses
- ✓ Can be offered in any medical setting
- ✓ Comes in daily pill or monthly injection
- ✓ Works for both opioids and alcohol
