Medications for opioid use disorder bring stability into people's lives, so they can work on healing trauma, building resilience, and learning new coping tools.



Use medication to help reduce overdose risk.

Medication reduces the number of deaths from overdose. It also can reduce chronic pain, cravings, and the risk of resuming substance misuse.



Stick with it to find the right treatment.

MOUD is available on different schedules and in different forms. Health care providers can help each individual find the right medication and dose for them.
