Medication reduces the number of deaths from overdose. It also can reduce chronic pain, cravings, and the risk of resuming substance misuse.

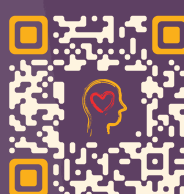


**Stick with it to find the right treatment.**
