## Native people who carry naloxone are **saving lives.**

### YOU CAN STOP A FENTANYL OVERDOSE



#### Check for the signs.

The person might seem asleep. It may be an opioid overdose if you can't wake them up or they're breathing strangely or making a gurgling sound. Their skin or nails might be cool, blueish, or pale.



#### Call 911.

If you can, stay with the person until help arrives.



#### Give them naloxone (Narcan).

If you don't see a response within two or three minutes, use another dose.



#### Do CPR.

If the person still isn't breathing or doesn't have a pulse, do chest compressions and rescue breaths.
